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Dear Comrades and Auxiliary Members,

The Post/Auxiliary Meat Raffle originally scheduled for Friday, May 15th has been postponed until Saturday, October 24th. As the event gets closer, we will once again be looking for members to purchase tickets and volunteer. Events like the Meat Raffle help raise funds for our annual community events such as the Easter Bunny Breakfast, Trunk or Treat, and the Children's Christmas Party. Without successful fundraisers, these events may have to be canceled, and I would truly hate to see that happen.

A reminder that the Annual Poppy Drive will be held Memorial Day weekend on Friday, May 22nd, Saturday, May 23rd, and Sunday, May 24th, 2026, at the Hamburg Walmart located on Southwestern Boulevard from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. I understand this is a busy time for everyone; however, I am only asking for one hour of your time over the course of the three-day event. We are looking for volunteers to assist with the Poppy Drive by standing or sitting outside the Walmart entrances (grocery, main, and garden center) to collect donations from Walmart patrons. You do not have to approach anyone — people come to you. Many community members know this is a yearly tradition and look forward to receiving their poppy flower.

Volunteer sign-up sheets are posted on the bulletin board in the lounge, or you may contact John Redmond at (716) 863-3911 for additional information. All money collected is deposited into the Post/Auxiliary Relief Fund account and is used to assist veterans and their families in times of need. Poppies and collection cans will be available prior to Memorial Day weekend. Once you have completed your collection shift, please return all donations and any leftover poppies to the Post.

Memorial Day ceremonies will be held on Saturday, May 23rd at 9:30 a.m. at Lakeside Cemetery in the Field of Valor. The ceremony will include a presentation, 21-gun salute, and the playing of Taps.

On Monday, May 25th at 10:00 a.m., the Honor Guard will participate in the Memorial Day Parade, beginning at Pleasant Avenue and concluding at Memorial Park, where a brief ceremony will be held. At 2:00 p.m., we will hold our Post ceremony followed by a lunch prepared by our Auxiliary members. I hope all members will bring their friends and families to support these important ceremonies.

Beginning Sunday, June 7th, we will kick off our Music on the Patio series from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. All are welcome to bring a chair and enjoy live music on the patio. Hot dogs and hamburgers will be available for purchase. We simply ask that

no outside alcohol be brought onto VFW grounds, as the lounge will be open for beverages of your choice. A flyer with the band schedule is included in this newsletter and can also be found on the Hamburg Township VFW Post 1419 Facebook page.

Line Dancing is coming to VFW Post 1419 Oakwood! If you enjoy dancing and showing off your boot-scootin' boogie, join us on Wednesday, May 27th from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The event will then continue on the third Wednesday of each month thereafter. We are a large post with almost 600 members and our needs are ongoing, but typically only require small amounts of your time. Even though many have moved over the years, we still have 518 members living in WNY close to our post within a short drive. - We need some volunteers to help man our hot dog cart at the Hamburg Burgerfest on Saturday July 18th. If you can help fill a shift please contact John Redmond at 716-863-3911.

- We also need volunteers to man our hot dog cart for each of our **Summer Concert Series** events on the following Sundays from 2:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m: 6/7, 6/14, 6/21, 6/28, 7/5, 7/12, 7/19, 7/26, 8/2, 8/9, 8/23, and 8/30.

Please contact John Redmond at 716-863-3911 to schedule a time when you can help us. **This is the largest event we are holding this year and we need some people to cook dogs while listening to some great tunes.**

- One of our most important volunteer needs is for members to work setting up tables & chairs for events at our Oakwood Banquet Facility. We then tear it down, do some light cleaning and set back up for a new event. We probably average 1 to 2 events per week. Each work session is about 45 minutes. We run 2 crews. The morning crew starts around 11:00 but is flexible. The evening crew meets sometime after dinner. We **give all workers 2 free drink chips per event they volunteer for use at our post bar**. This is not heavy work and averages 3 or 4 people. This month I want to explain how this works a little differently. I understand if you have reluctance to commit to something ongoing which may interfere with your daily schedule. The way this job works is this. All members in this group have their names and phone numbers on file with the Oakwood Banquet Facility hall set-up supervisor. As set-up and tear down work becomes available on the calendar the supervisor sends out a group text. Each person responds with their availability. Some people have a doctor's appointment on that day and time or something else that prevents them from helping out. That is not a problem and it happens all the time. So you would not have to make every set-up. We just need a larger group so that the same people don't have to do it all the time. So if you can help out please contact Don Welsted at 716-308-1528.

- We are also in need of 1 or 2 people (maybe do it with a friend), to do an occasional "handyman" job here & there. These jobs are light in nature and one & done. They are the type of things you do at home. We hire contractors for major HVAC work or construction jobs so we are not asking anybody to do that type of work. Historical Facts Of Our Post

From time to time we will publish some interesting history about our post. One of our Directors, Russ Deveso, provided the following, transcribed from an neat old undated document in our archives. Thank you Russ.

The Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, Post 1419, Hamburg, New York, is a fraternal, patriotic, historical, charitable and educational organization.

VFW Post 1419 founded by National Charter in 1973, preserves and strengthens comradship among its members; perpetuates the memory and history of our deceased; we assist their widows and orphans; we maintain true allegiance to the government of the United States and fidelity to its constitution and laws; we foster true patriotism; maintain and extend the institutions of American freedom and last but not least, we preserve and defend the United States from all her enemies.

In 1975, the founding fathers of Post 1419 led by Lake Views's own WWII hero, Darby Ranger, James "Jimmy" Palmer, formed a 501 (c) 19 "Not For Profit" corporation under Federal and New York State law, that to be named "Hamburg Lakeshore Overseas Veterans, Inc." the home to VFW Post 1419, Veterans Of Foreign Wars of the United States. Since that time, it has grown from a handful of patriots to a membership of more than 400 members and from a very small cottage to the magnificent campus of the present , which also includes, in recent years, the addition of the Post 1419 Memorial Park and Museum".

Our membership operates a private lounge and a meeting room that can accommodate approximately 100 for private meetings or gatherings that welcomes the public as sponsored guests or rentals. (Dedal Room Holds 70) We also operate a banquet facility, the "Oakwood Manor", that can accommodate approximately 300 (270) for private meetings or gathering that welcomes the public as sponsored guests or rentals.

Approximately twenty-five years ago, the Post 1419 "Memorial Park and Museum" was established. The static display area is clearly visible on Lakeview Road. The museum will have artifacts from our Nation's conflicts; the evidence of our protection of America's freedom. The central purpose of the museum and display is to memorialize all military veterans as captured by the quote, "All gave some, some gave all". We will educate the community of the sacrifices made to preserve and defend the Constitution of the United States.

By National Charter, VFWs are only allowed to publicly solicit funds one time per year, around Memorial Day. All the money collected goes to a "Relief Fund dedicated to our disabled veterans.

The Veterans of VFW Post 1419 are very proud of our legacy and proud to be leaders and protectors of the Lake View community.
