#### **SERVICE OFFICER**

The bipartisan legislation will increase certain VA benefits including disability compensation, clothing President Biden signed S. 777, Veterans' Compensation Cost-of-Living Adjustment Act of 2023 into law. allowances, and dependency and indemnity compensation (DIC) for surviving spouses and children to reflect increases in the cost of living. It will directly benefit millions of disabled veterans and military survivors nationwide.

The Department of Veterans Affairs has awarded \$11.5 million in legal services grants to help homeless veterans or those who are at risk of experiencing homelessness. These first-of-their-kind grants were made available through VA's new Legal Services for Veterans Grant Program. They were awarded to 79 public or non-profit organizations to help veterans with various legal needs to ensure they retain their housing. Legal services – particularly civil legal services that support accessing government benefits, navigating family law, ensuring access to safe housing, and assisting with debt – can all be critical to resolving or preventing homelessness.
